- Be responsible for your actions and act in a Christian manner.

- 5. I will treat adult leaders, myself, and other members of the youth group with respect*.
- 6. I will cause no emotional or physical injury to myself or others.
- 7. I will respect* others by avoiding inappropriate sexual activity and will not engage in sexual misconduct, which includes but is not limited to inappropriate jokes, comments, or touching; viewing inappropriate materials; wearing clothing that is immodest, offensive, vulgar, or inappropriate; or listening to music with offensive lyrics.
- 8. I will relinquish my cell phone or other electronic devices to the leaders if they request me to do so during youth events.
- 9. I will be responsible for my actions and will act in a Christian manner.

In addition to these promises, I agree to work in harmony** with the leaders and members of the group by participating in activities. I will also respect* the opinions of others and care for my peers as sisters and brothers in Christ. I agree to listen and adhere to all the instructions by the adult leaders. If I ameighteen years of age or older, I understand that I am attending this activity as a participant and have no authority over any other participants.

I understand that if I fail to comply with any of the above promises, I will be held personally responsible for any injuries or property damage that may result from my actions. Depending upon the nature and severity of the violation, I understand that I may be reprimanded, that my parents may be notified of my behavior, that I may be removed from the activity at my parent or guardian's expense, that I may be referred to local law enforcement, and that my future privilege to participate in Christ United Methodist Church youth events may be jeopardized.
